



### HELPFUL HINTS:

- An easy way to prepare for these assessments is to answer the questions as you read or annotate your book with sticky notes or highlighters.
- If you do this, you will not have to go searching for the information you read a few weeks prior to starting the project.
- To earn full credit for each answer, you must use grammatically correct and structurally sound sentences, as well as detailed answers and specific examples from the books. See the examples if you are unsure what this “looks like.”
- When a box is provided for your answer, the teacher anticipates that it will take you that much space to answer the question or respond to the statement completely.
- This is a formal writing assignment. Use formal language appropriate for your audience. Assignments are due **BY THE SECOND WEEK** of school.
- Assignments turned in after that time will earn partial credit or zeroes.
- Summer reading entries turned in based on class novels read the previous year will not be accepted.

Completed summer reading assignments **must be completed and turned in by the second week of school to your English teacher.**
